**Project Name:** Replace Troop Quarters

**Service:** Air National Guard

**Location:** Alpena Combat Readiness Training Center

**Amount Requested:** \$8.5 million

**Justification/Explanation:** This project will build a billeting facility that will house 155 personnel and will meet appropriate force protection standoff distance requirements. The current temporary block-framed structures were built in the early 1950s. The facilities do not meet current fire protection standards, and have numerous safety violations. The current quarters provide inadequate sleeping accommodations for deploying personnel, inefficient processing of units and, therefore, loss of quality training.

**Project Name:** Component Numbered Air Force Bed Down Facilities

**Service:** Air National Guard

**Location:** Battle Creek Air National Guard Base

**Amount Requested:** \$13.9 million

**Justification/Explanation:** The 110th Fighter Wing requires properly sized and adequately configured facilities for the new Component Numbered Air Force (CNAF) Warfighting Headquarters mission. The CNAF Warfighting Headquarters mission at Battle Creek Air National Guard Base includes a Command Support Element, Air Operations Squadron, Air Intelligence Squadron, Air Communications Squadron, Air Operations Center, and an Air Mobility Squadron.

**Project Name:** Organizational Maintenance Shop

**Service:** Army National Guard

**Location:** Fort Custer

**Amount Requested:** \$7.7 million

**Justification/Explanation:** This project consists of demolition and reconstruction of an OMS that was incorrectly constructed by the General Contractor. The General Contractor defaulted on the project and subsequent engineering investigations found the structure unsafe and not repairable. Project consists of a combined Unit Training Equipment Site (UTES), and a consolidated Organizational Maintenance Shop (OMS) with drive-thru work bays for oversized military equipment fielding by the Army National Guard Division Redesign Study (ADRS).

**Project Name:** Barracks Replacement, Phase II

**Service:** Army National Guard

**Location:** Camp Grayling

**Amount Requested:** \$16.9 million

**Justification/Explanation:** The soldier billeting areas of Camp Grayling were built in increments beginning in the 1950s. The current facilities do not meet existing fire protection standards, have numerous safety violations and provide inadequate sleeping accommodations for deploying personnel. The first phase of this project was funding in the fiscal year 2009 Military Construction and Veterans Affairs Appropriations bill.

**Project Name:** A-10 Squad Operations Facility

**Service:** Air National Guard

**Location:** Selfridge Air National Guard Base

**Amount Requested:** \$6.2 million

**Justification/Explanation:** This project would create an efficient and properly configured workspace for the 127th Wing A-10 Squadron Operations Command Function, Embedded Combat Weather, Survival Equipment, and Flight Simulator Training (1 A-10 Simulator).
